It should — it's a common, everyday segment of the ultimate "sitcom" of actual life as it's being lived by many, many millions of Americans, Canadians, Australians and Britons.

Day-to-Day Grind

The resigned defeatism; the stifling, "not-quite-enough" battle of day-to-day existence calls upon those who are honest to wage endless combat with the creditors; juggling checks to ensure the "squeaky wheel gets the grease," eking out an existence.

Dreams.

Doesn't everybody have them? By the millions, though we worry about inflation, Joblessness, high interest rates, poor leadership, strikes, high food, costs, we dream about that "somewhere-over-the-rainbow" time when all will be well; when hopes and dreams of "easy street" finally materialize.

But they hever do, except in the movies.

But what's really important in life? Is it that proverbial pot of goldat the end of the rainbow? Is it getmotorized bedspring you call an automobile? Is that why you make those inevitable, inflated monthly payments to pay for that mechanical monster? Is that why you pay hundreds of dollars every year to pour Mideast or domestic gasoline through the crud-incrusted carburetor of that air-polluting machine that sits grinning with chrome-plated satisfaction in your driveway?

Is your whole heart and soul addicted to the pursuit of wealth in a capricious and wildly fluctuating stock market? Does it really matter in the final analysis whether it was blue chip, green chip or purple chip? What's the 'point of it all; where does it all end?

In the great Depression of the thirties, dozens of investors and financiers threw themselves out of windows of their Wall Street offices because years of careful investments had gone down the drain. They had been sacrificed on the altar of financial futility.

But suppose you did make it to the top of the financial heap — what then? Will your stack taste any more succulent than that of the middlecrease: this is also vanity [futility, emptiness]. When goods increase, they are increased that eat them: and what good is there to the owners thereof, saving the beholding of them with their eyes?... and what profit hath he that hath laboured for the wind?" (Eccl. 5:10-16.)

Do you labor for the wind? Or Montgomery Ward? Or Sears? Or BankAmericard? It's all the same — it's all a kind of futility and frustration! There's nothing to show for it except a few more material goods, a little more temporary comfort, a few more steaks, and finally, an empty death. And remember the old cliche—you can't take it with you!

There's nothing so wrong with the picture of the frustrated, middle-income housewife sending her husband off to work, except the mental approach and attitude!

If they knew the true values in life—
if they deeply appreciated that
little foreign compact (with higher,
mileage); the limited, but adequate
appliances; those three logely children; a steady job; and were following more of a practical, workable
manner of managing their personal
finances—the "not quites" of unrealized dreams, the juggling of bills
to pay for impulsive buying, and the
endless battles with creditors, plus a
sprinkling of arguments among
themselves, would not be present.

Millions play the game of impulse buying, fight the creditors, and amove away if the pressure becomes unbearable.

But it doesn't have to be that way!

There is a better way; there is a way by which you can obtain eternal dividends for a sound physical financial investment in this life!

Is your heart really in that popping, rattling, squeaking, lurching mecome office worker who serves you? Will fine music sound any more pleasing to your ear than so the ear of a starving Indian peasant?

And what can anyone do with all the goods they might accumulate except look at them, fondle them, think about them and perhaps boast just a little?

King Solomon, in his God-given wisdom, said: "He that loveth silver shall not be satisfied with silver; soo he that loveth abundance with in-

breathe! It is the Work of the God who claims that "the silver and the gold are mine" (Haggai 2:8). It is the Work of the God who says you and I should be willing to give our all in His service.

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service" (Rom. 12:1).

It is not unreasonable of God to even expect us to give our entire-beings in sacrifice to His service. Should it be some great thing that God would then expect His people to support His Work materially?

A Short Work

thy to escape all these things [the global series of crises, outlined in previous verses] that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man."

The context of this scripture makes it crystal clear that the term "escape" refers to a physical salvation from a terrible time of calamity soon to hit this whole earth (see also isa, 26:20; Rev. 3:10).

That's right, PHYSICAL SALVA-

Peter, at the conclusion of his powerful sermon (Acts, 2nd chapter) on the day of Pentecost, said: "Save yourselves from this untoward generation." He knew what Jesus had said about impending national calamities.

Peter knew someone was going to get hurt!

Jesus had told them about two sensational tragedies: one, involving the mass murder of a group of Galileans who had been butchered right along with their sacrifices; and another, the well-known deaths of a large group of people peacefully string in the shade of a big wall in Siloam (Luke 13:1-6).

He had said: "... Except ye RE-PENT, ye shall all LIKEWISE perish"!

Jesus wasn't speaking of the fact it is "given to all men once to die" - which did occur nearly 40 years later.

Jesus knew drought, famine, pestilence, mindless tortures (according to the Jewish historian Josephus, the Romans impaled thousands!), and death by sword, spear and bludgeon would be the lot of those who did not repent, and who were not watching the development of events!

What to Watch

That's why Jesus said "WATCH ye, therefore." He said WATCH - NOT in some "spiritual" way, meaning staring out a candle-lit window in an attitude of "prayer." the way some might "spiritualize" this scripture away: but watching the weather patterns; the picture of public health; international, geopolitical maneuverings; military struggles; alliances and power blocs; watch world news!

He said watch so YOU CAN ES-CAPE!

Escape is no "spiritual" kind of "rapture"!

lesus plainly told those which "be in Judea" to FLEE when they saw armies beginning to surround Jerusalem. He said those would be the "days of vengeance" — and described bloody, mass MURDER!

Like it or not - unpleasant to

ncreasing taxes, soaring inflation, more and more credit buying, rising costs of goods and services and other economic realities are rapidly taking their toll on the average American family.

Staggering personal and private debt is rapidly becoming a way of life in the United States. Skyrocketing interest rates and the high cost of "easy." credit are beginning to paint John Q. Public into an economic corner.

At the end of 1972 the average consumer debt per house hold in the United States was \$2,312. Of this amount \$1,869 represented installment credit.

interest rates on such payments could be as high as 18-21% in some cases even higher!

In January 1974 – according to the "U.S. Census Bureau Current Population Report: Consumer Income, Series P-60" — the average weekly earnings, were \$147.13 per week. The average hourly wage was \$4.02 A skilled construction worker could earn up to \$9.89 per hour and an apparel or textile worker as little as \$1.85 per hour.

But inflation has seriously damaged the buying power of the dollar. In 1974 you would have to earn \$140 to equal the buying power of \$100 in 1967!

Taxes and inflation rates are even greater in many other countries. In spite of its devastating effect on the American consumer, the United States actually has one of the lower rates of inflation in the world community! Such nations as Japan, Australia, Sweden and even Great Britain suffer from enormously high taxation and mind-boggling inflation. Strikes and work stoppages deal devastating blows to the economies of such nations as Canada, England and France: Socialized medicine and the welfare state mentality push taxes higher and higher in countries already beset with major economic difficulties.

But this worldwide Work of God must continue! What better investment could there be for today's Christian than to support the very Work being done, by the servants of the living God in these twilight years of man's age?

Now - you live in the time of mass murder! This great world girdling Work is established as God's WATCHMAN to see, and understand, and report on these prophetic conditions; to "ory aloud, and spare not, and show my reople their sins." And with Ezekiel, to cry, "TURN YE, TURN YE, for why will you die, O Ispael?"

Nowhere else will you find a voice of alarm, a voice of warning

about our impending national calamities unless we repent of our personal and national sins, just as Jesus said!

There is no other commission any, more important now!

Jesus Christ is Savior, yes! He died to atome for our just, and by His intercessory Lare (Rom. 5:10) we are saved spiritually, for eternity!

But Jesus also talked of a way of escape from all these things that shall come to pass — He warned those living in His day to fee for their lives when they clearly saw the events He predicted coming to pass.

Through His written Word, the prophecies of your Bible and Jesus' own prophecies, He warns us today to watch, and to warn others of impending calamities!

Chrisi meant for us to watch world conditions—not minor, local day-to-day events; but the big trends in major power blocs, the big economic struggles between nations, the major fluctuations in world religious.

In His famous Olivet prophecy (Luke 21; Matt. 24; Mark 13), Jesus was describing what to watch—long-range, overall world conditions (now beginning to intensify with fantastic rapidity!), which would lead up to His coming rule on this earth.

Just ahead of us is a global food crisis. We are right now, as of this moment, in a global governmental crisis. We have been in the throes of a global ecology crisis for nearly two decades; and the current potential for a global economic crisis is truly frightening.

But watching all of these many world conditions does not remotely imply a selfish "escape hatch" sulvation for those who have been called to perform find's Work.

We must be the advance news reporters who executly analyze and digest the world scene, and then, coupled with Bible prophecy and the backdrop of recent history, Give our a warning and a witness such as this world has nover heard before!

The Watchman

Ezekiel wrote of a "watchman' (Ezek. 33) whom God would inspire to foresee impending national calamities. The prophet issued the rnly worded warning that if the watchman failed to perform his God-ordained compission, the blood of the people dying in a cataclysmic death-dealing nuclear bloodbath would be on his head (verses 3-6). As modern Christians - having understanding of the mind shattering propagates for this day and age - how can we fail to feel a sense of moral obligation to warn this society?

What an awesome responsibility!

As I mentioned earlier, somehow

New Testament Principle

In the theocracy of Israel, the people paid tithes on their crops and cattle to the Levites, who in turn tithed to the priests. The priests ministered in the Temple, doing the Work of God in their day. The Apostle Paul wrote of this in I Corinthians 9:13-14:

"Do ye not know that they which minister about holy things live of the things of the temple? and they which wait at the altar are partakers with the altar? Even so hath the Lord [Christ] ordained that they which preach the gospel should live of the gospel."

Paul showed that he and the other aposties had the power or authority to partake of their physical, carnal things — money — for the purpose of doing the Work! After all, who should be expected to finance his own ministry? What soldier ever went to war of his own charges (see verse 7) — at his own expense?

The Church is to preach and publish the gospel; that is the collective commission to the whole Body of Christ (Matt. 28:19-20; Mark 16:15-16, etc.). But not everyone in the Church is a preacher or an evangelist (I Cor. 12). Each member of the Body has a different gift, but, it is the living, active, dynamic Christ who works in every one through the Holy Spirit to do His Work.

All Members Responsible

But all members, morally, philosophically and financially, are to support the Work of the whole Body. The preaching of the gospel represents the Church's relationship with the world—it is the way-the Church provides the world with light and truth.

God never intended the Church of God to be self-serving and with-drawn – descending into an endless series of time-consuming, comfortable armchair arguments over the whys or wherefores of this or that minor doctrine. He raised up the Church (Matt. 16:18) to preach the goppel of the Kingdom and to set a right example before the world

When Jesus was confronted by a rich, young nobleman who asked what he must do in order to inherit elemal life, Christ told him to keep the Ten Commandments (Matt. 19:16-19). This young businessman asserted that he always had kept them (verse 20).

But Jesus knew that he was very covetous of his vast material wealth; more concerned with hanging on to what he had accumulated than following Christ.

"Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect [complete or fulfilled], go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me. But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for the had great possessions" (Matt. 19:21-22).

This young man was covetous, unwilling to sacrifice his material goods in order to follow Christ, who was doing the Work of His Father. He lived only for this life.

Why do we draw breath? Why do we work, labor and sweat in this life? Is it merely to perpetuate our own very temporary existences? Solomon said: "All the labour of man is for his mouth, and yet the appetite is not filled" (Eccl. 6:7).

God has given us a far greater reason for living than just feeding our faces every so often. He is working out a purpose on this earth through His Church. And that great purpose involves fiduciary and financial involvement!

Your Financial Priorities

Jesus Christ continually warned His disciples about the danger of overanxious concern regarding the physical necessities and staples of this life (Matt. 6:24-32). He pointed out the one great priority that would forever overcome the selfish materialism so instinctive to human beings: "But seek we first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these (material) things shall be added unto you" (verse 33).

Notice the concluding, crux point to the parable of the unjust steward: "Make to yourselves friends of the mammon of unrighteousness, that, when ye (it - RSV) fail, they may receive you into everlasting habitations," (Luke 16:9):

And then Jesus steraly warned:

Since 1945 the nations have been working feveriship to develop more devastating weapons — weapons which can crase vast populations in a matter of seconds. The word overkill has carned its place in dur modern vocabulary. The nations have already spent many millions developing brands of superlaser weapons. Besides the United States and Russia — France, Britain, Thuna and India (and who knows how many other nations?) also have much a weapons in their arsenals.

Nearly two thousand years ago, Jesus Christ foretold this terrible era of potential mass destruction—thus end time when man would possess the capability to annihilate all life on this planet: "For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved [allive]..." (Matt. 24:21-22).

Who Can Know the Future?

There is a Creator God who knows the past and can fathom the future. He has given us in His Word, the Holy Bible, many hundreds of

prophecies which foretell future

The Creator says: "... For I am God, and there is none like the food and there is none like the declaring the end from the beginning and from antient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure" (Isa. 46:9-10).

It is God who knows the end from the beginning. His Word, if divigently studied and rightly understood, reveals to mankind many of the major events about to occur in the Mideast.

Amazing Future Prophecy

The Prophet Daniel prophesied, that four great world-ruling empires would arree one after the other (see Daniel 2 and 7). These empires would dominate this earth up until the end time when the stone" (the Messiah or Christ — see Daniel 2:45 and Ephesians 2:40) would demolish and supplant all human governments.

The longest prophecy of the Bible, the eleventh chapter of Daniel, specifically concerns the Middle East Most of this lengthy prophecy has already been fulfilled. The first four verses of this chapter proph-

esied that "a mighty king" (Alexander the Great) would rive up and defeat the Persians. He would die without "posterity" to nulle on his throne. His kingdom would be "diwided toward the four winds" (by his four generals).


Then we come to the very detailed prophery concerning a prolonged struggle between the Seleucid kings of "the north" in Syria and the Protessan kings of "the south" in Fig. 1911.

History shows how accurately the detailed prophecies of verses 5-39 were fulfilled (For a description of the historical fulfillment of these verses, write for our free article entitled "The Middle East in Prophecy") But verses 40-45 are yet to be fulfilled. They reveal that startling events are yet to take place in the Middlest.

As foresold, after the death of Alexander the Great his four generals divided up his kingdom. Cassander ruled Greece and Macedonia. Lysimachus was given Asia Munor. Seleucus (Nicator) ruled Syria and Babylonia as far as fidia Ptolemy (Soter) ruled Egypt, part of Ethiopia (including the modern Sudam). Judea and part of Syria.

The kings of the morth and south

referred to in this chapter were the Greek rulers of Egypt and Syria: who for centuries struggled over control of Palestine. The Bible always speaks from the focal point of the Holy Land. Syria was north of Palestine, Egypt was south.

The "king of the north" continued to be Syria up until 65 B.C. (see box. on page 15). From that time on the "king of the north" represents the

Roman Empire.

Rome is the fourth and last of the world-ruling empires which Daniel prophesied would dominate this world (Daniel 2 and 7). The Roman Empire would meet catastrophe and be revived again and again. It would continue to reappear until the Messiah appears on the scene and destroys all human kingdoms and governments, and establishes the Kingdom of God.

The Seven Heads

The ancient Roman Empire fell to the Heruli and their allies in A.D. 476. Then Justinian revived the Roman Empire in the West in A.D. 554. It was, in our time, revived by Benito Mussolini. Il Duce, the leader ruled the sixth major revival

of the Roman Empire.

According to the prophecies of your Bible, there were to be seven major "heads" (leaders) or seven revivals of the Roman Empire, beginning A.D. 554 when the "deadly" wound" was healed by Justinian (Rev. 13:3-5). The other "resurrections" of the Roman Empire include those of Charlemagne, Otto the Great, Charles the Great (of the Hapsburgs), Napoleon and Mussolini-Hitler. (These first six revivals... are being described sectally in the Plain Truth magazine under the continuing title "Europe, Catastrophe and Revival.") The seventh and final revival is yet to occur.

Students of biblical prophecy generally understand that the fourth kingdom mentioned by Daniel (depicted by the legs of iron, and feet part of iron and part of clay) is the Roman Empire (Dan. 2:32-45). "And in the days of these kings [ten-

kings represented by the "ten toes"] shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces smite the image on its feet and toes of from and clay] and consume all these kingdoms. and it shall stand for ever" (Dan. 2:44).

The seventh chapter of Daniel. lists four beasts: lion, bear, leopard and a "fourth beast, dreadful and terrible," unlike any beast known to mankind.

Daniel was inspired to foretell the destruction of this fourth beast (the Roman Empire): "... I beheld even till the beast was slain, and his bodydestroyed, and given to the burning

flame" (Dan. 7:11).

Then follows the coming of the Messiah to this earth in power and glory: "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven.... And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed" (verses 13-14).

Very few understand that the Roman Empire is to exist, quite literally, at the coming of the Messiah, and once again will wreak great havoc in the name of peace - just before the establishment of the prophesied Kingdom of God on this carth.

For many years the Plain Truth and The World Tomorrow broadcast have been warning that these Bible prophecies foretell the coming of a United States of Europe.

United States of Europe

Immediately after World Wi Winston Churchill, in a speci Zurich, urged the creation of a "United States of Europe." Since that time, many steps have been taken toward achieving this goal. Although at this date all nine members of the European Economic Community are not in favor biforming a politically strong United States of Europe - yet a New Europe is coming as certainly as the sun will continue to rise and set.

Many Europeans reglize they will forever remain impotent as individual nations unless they can bind themselves together in a strong union Quly then can they speak with a strong, united voice and exercise their political and military power to utmost advantage.

The recent war in the Mideast painfully underlined Europe's weakness in international disputes The nations of the EEC were forced to stand by as the United States and Russia made the important decisions concerning the October 73 Middle East struggle without even consulting them. Europeans charge that they were not only not consulted, but they were only informed belatedly - after the international situation in the Mideast had deteriorated to the point where the United States felt impelled to put her forces (including those on European soil) on full alert.

Europeans now are demanding a. bigger say in what goes on in the world - including the Middle East, where their umbilical oil line could be severed without either their knowledge or consent.

In order to have more freedom to maneuver in future crises, Europeans are continuing to consider steps to bring about their own political and military independence from United States control and influence.

Daniel prophesied over 2500 years ago that Europe will sooner or later end up with a strong central government (like that of the ancient Roman Empire).

This strong United Europe is foretold in the seventeenth chapter of Revelation: "And the beast [the final manifestation of the Roman Empire] that was, and is not, even he is the eighth [head], and is of the seven [of the seven heads of Daniel 7:4-7], and goeth perdition" (Rev. 17:11).

The Coming Beest

Now notice that "the beast" (the leader of this final revival of the Roman Empire) will have under his control and direction the full power of "ten kings" or ten rulers who will give him full allegiance: "And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast. These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. These [the beast and the ten kings] shall make war with the Lamb [Christ at His coming], and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings ... (verses 12-14). .

This battle, to occur near Jerusadem (see Zech. 14:1-4), is described in chapter 16 of the book of Revela-

tion:

The kings of the earth and of the whole world [are marshaled by the derion world]...into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon" (verses 12-16).

For thousands of years, Megiddo has been a most strategic place, the very crossroads of the Middle East. These kings and their armies meet at Megiddo, then move south to the valley of Jehoshaphat (near Jerusalem) where the climactic battle actually takes place. "And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gattered together to make war against him [the returning Christ] that sat on the horse, and against his army. And the beast was taken, and with him the false

prophet.... These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. And the remnant were alain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse... and all the fowls were filled with their flesh. (Rev. 19:19-21).

As we read earlier, this same annihilation of the beast is described in Daniel: "... I beheld even till the beast [the human head of the coming ten-nation combine] was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame? (Dan. 7:11).

In the Bible a king often represents the kingdom (see Daniel 2:38-39; 7:17, 23). So these "beasts" are human governments or kingdoms which have plundered and destroyed the nations down through the centuries. They have acted like wild beasts. That appears to be why God compares them to ravening animals.

Now return to the eleventh chapter of Daniel.

We have seen that the king of the north was Syria — until that nation was swallowed up by Rome and became part of the Roman Empire. From that time forth, the successive kings of the north were the successive leaders of the Roman Empire.

We have also seen that the Koman Empire would have seven heads or revivals, beginning with Justinian in A.D. 554. The seventh (last) head of this Roman Empire is yet to arise — maybe sooner than we think!

The Mussolini-Hitler kingdom was the sixth head of the beast. The next leader to unite the peoples of Europe will constitute the "beast" mentioned in Daniel and Revetation. He will also be the "king of the north" mentioned in Daniel 11:40-45

End-Time Prophecy

Why will this, "king of the north" become involved in the Middle East? Because the Mideast is of great importance strategically. It is at the very geographical center of the earth—the vital crossroads between three continents. Also, it is

very important because it boasts over 50 percent of the world's proven oil reserves.

Now let's pick up that part of this prophecy that has been fulfilled in just the last 80 years: "And at the time of the end [this was in 1895] 1896] shall the king of the south [Ethiopia] push at him [Italy in Eritreal: and the king of the north-[Italy under Mussolini] shall come against him like a whirlwind (from the air with fighter planes and bombers], with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries. and shall overflow and pass over" (verse 40). Mussolini fulfilled verse 40 - but not verse 41. Mussolini as "king of the north" ald not enter into Palestine. He was stopped in Egypt.

Which countries is the coming "king of the north" prophesied to enter? Which nations will he conquer? Verse 41 shows that he will move into what has been called Palestine: "He shall enter also into the glorious land [the Holy Land], and many countries shall be over thrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon."

What about Egypt? Will it be subject to the coming "king of the north"? "... And the land of Egypt shall not escape" (verse 42).

Verse 43 says that "the Libyans and the Ethiopians [meaning week Cushite peoples of the Sudan and probably Ethiopia] shall be at his steps."

But at this point in time, the "king of the north" is going to hear some starming news — probably a military threat from Russia and those nations allied with her. "But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many" (verse 44).

Beast and False Prophet in Jerusalem

Notice how this king will move his headquarters to Jerusalem: And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him" (yerse 45).

He will set his palace in Mount Zion, which is situated between the Mediterranean and Dead seas.

We have already seen that the beast of Revelation 17 and 19 will fight the Messiah at the valley of Jehoshaphat — near Jerusalem. But a "false prophet," a great false religious leader, will also move his headquarters to Jerusalem. This is strongly indicated in II Thessalonians 2:1-8.

This same "false prophet" is called the "man of sin" and the "son of perdition" (II Thess. 2:3). He is described as one "Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God shewing himself that he is God" (verse 4).

Jerusalem — Under the Gentile Heel?

The "king of the north" is going to move to Mount Zion, and he will be joined there by the false prophet who will work great miracles. This king of the north (also called the "beast") will at a later date take half of the people of Jerusalem into captivity.

The "beast" and "false prophet" will both be in Jerusalem to oppose Christ when He returns to this earth in dazzling power and glory. The horrible punishment of these two evil leaders is described in Revelation 19:20.

Now notice Jesus' prophecy regarding Jerusalem at the time just before His second coming: "And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh. Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains. For these be the days of vengeance. For there, shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people" (Luke 21:20-23).

Verse 24 has certainly not yet

been completely fulfilled — eventhough it was partially fulfilled in A.D. 70 when Jerusalem was destroyed by Roman armies: "And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles," until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled."

God tells of a coming great battle

"And this shall be the plague wherewith the Lord will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes [sockets], and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth" (Zech. 14:12).

The mighty power of God will bring about this instantaneous

THE KING OF THE NORTH

The king of the north was Syria under the Seleucid dynasty. In 65 B.C. Pompey reduced Syria to the status of a Roman province, despite the pleadings of Antiochus XIII. The line of Seleucus continued in the kings of Commagene, who continued to rule until A.D. 72 when it soo was extinguished by Rome. The son of the last king, Caius Julius Antiochus Epiphanes Philopappus served as a Roman consul in the

year A.D. 100. Thus Rome swallowed up the western Seleucid empire, utterly abolishing it. The eastern area broke up into independent kingdoms under local rulers. Rome also took Macedonia and Greece, renaming it Achaia. In the celebrated story of Cleopatra we note that Egypt too fell into the Roman sphere, but Ethiopia remained an independent area continuing the traditions of the "king of the south."

to occur near Jerusalem: "For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifted, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity; and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city. Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle" (Zech. 14:2-3).

When will this take place? It will be at the second coming of Christ. "And his feet [Christ's] shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives... And the Lord my God shall come, and all the saints with thee" (verses 4, 5). (Compare 1 Thessalonians 4:14-17, I Corinthians 15:51-54 and Revelation 11:15-18.)

Then occurs the terrible destruction which will befall those who fight against Christ at Jerusalem: death. It even sounds somewhat like what happened at Hiroshima and Nagasaki!


Lasting Peace Prophesied for Our Time

Campaign Possponed

After many preliminary arrangements, the campaign was originally set for March 1, 2 and 3.

In the last week of February Mr. Armstrong arrived at the Manila International Airport to a warm welcome from government officials and friends. Mr. Leslie McCullough (director of the International Division of the Worldwide Church of Godk his wife, and my wife and I were also there to greet him, the was interviewed in the VIP lounge by a local television station, and the newspapers carried extensive coverage of his arrival and campaign plans.

A few days later with deep regret.

Mr. Agnistrong had to cancel the campaign and fly back to Pasadena on urgent business. On leaving the airport he referred to the famous words of General Douglas Mac-Arthur. "I shall return!" He was genginely sorry to have to leave the Philippines, but was determined to return as soon as possible to fulfill his commitments.

On April 20 we received the good news that Mr. Armstrong would

conduct the campaign on May 17. 18 and 19. Mr. Osamu Gotoh, our overseas campaign director, flew to Manila to arrange the details and begin the publicity effort: Around eighteen thousand Plain Truth readers in the greater Manila area teceived letters inviting them to hear Mr. Armstrong.

A Week of Activities

On May 11, Mr. Armstrong (accompanied by Stanley Rader, legal counsel of Ambassador College, and other staff members), flew into Manila International Amport for the second time in three months.

That day Mr. Armstrong spoke to the Manila congregation of the Worldwide Church of God:

The next day. Sunday, he spoke before over 200 members of the Knights of Columbus and the Daughters of Isabella at the Hyatt Regency Hotel In the evening he was an honored dinner guest, along with the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court and an Associate Justice, at the home of former Philippine Vice President Lipez.

On Monday interning, May 13. Mr. Atinstrong tistied the office of Mayor Bagatsing of Manila, where he was presented with the symbolic lex to the city. strong left Manila and traveled north to Angeles City to visit Angeles University, where an honorary doctor's degree in humanities was conferred upon him Mr Armstrong spoke to the assembled crowd concerning the missing dimension in education.

After lunch he was interviewed by television's Channel 2 at the Hyatt Hotel. He had dinner that evening with the president and general manager of the Times Journal of Manila, Mrs. Rosario Oliveras.

A busy joined of activities continued Wednesday Mr. Armstrong spoke at a luncheon at the Kiwanis Club in the Manila Hilton. Later in the afternoon he departed for the University of the East to aftern a convocation. Then he was interviewed for a Channel 13 public affairs program.

On Thursday, May 16, Mr. Armstrong attended a luncheon with Secretary Francisco Tatad of the Department of Public Information.

On Friday, President Ferdinand Marcos very warmly received Mr. Armstrong at Malacknang Palace. The President had already seen the June-July Plain Truth and had even read the cover story about the Philippines — which seemed to please him. He heartily endorsed Mr. Armstrong's campaign to the people of the Philippines.

Opening Night

After resting and preparing his lecture Friday. Mr. Armstrong headed for the Coliseum at 6:30 p.m.

My wife and I had arrived there a little after 6 p.m. and found an excited group of ushers dressed in bright uniforms. The men wore red jackets and white pants with large red how ties; the ladies wore white dresses with red vests. Most of these young people were members of the Manila Church of God Choir. Their neat: clean-cut appearance and friendliness made everyone feel welcome.

As the public arrived, they were given packaged envelopes containing the June July Plain Truth, a brochure about the campaign. Mr. Armstrong's biography, tickets for the following night, and a copy of the child-rearing booklet.

A little after 1, p.m., Mr. Armstrong came on stage - followed by Mr. Gotoh, Mr. Rader, Mr. and Mrs. Santiago de la Critz (he is president of the University of the East). Mrs. Marcos (mother of the President), and Mr. Emmanuel Angeles (executive vice-president of Angeles University).

Mr. Goluh was the master of ceremonies and gave a short history of how the sampaign had come about He then introduced Mr. Angeles, who formally welcomed Mr. Armstrong to the Philippines.

President de la Gruz spotte next. In his speech, he mentioned how he had met Mr. Armstrong a few moratis before and had had the pleasure of attending the opening teremonies of the Ambassador Auditorium in Pasadena. He praised Mr. Armstrong as a unique individual and read a portion from Mr. Armstrong a autobiography, giving

a short explanation of the seven laws of success.

After this introduction, Mr. Armstrong began his lecture. The largerowd fell silent as he began to speak.

In his opening sentences Mr. Armstrong spoke of the state of the world, with its crime, population explosion and war. He remarked about what a paradox it is that man can accomplish amazing things, even sending men to the moon and back, and yet mankind can't seem to solve his problems here on earth. He asked why man is as he is and also forcefully stated that the world is headed into the supreme crisis at the end of this age.

Survival is the number one problem. He spoke about the events of 1973, the toppling of governments, the conditions within the United States, and his own personal talks with heads of state. He mentioned that human beings had worked for peace for 6,000 years and yet were no nearer to it today that before, because they do not know the way to peace.

Mr. Armstrong then spoke of his personal study to find the answers to life's questions. He pointed out how he found those answers in the Bible, answers which are ignored in the educational establishments.

The right answer: he said, is found in the opening chapters of Genesis. He then proceeded to expound on the creation of man and explain briefly what the spirit in man is. He stressed forcefully that humans are not—and do not have—immortal souls, but are composed of physical, mortal matter.

Mr. Armstrong showed how God taught our first parents. Adam and Eve, how to live God instrumed them about what love is, but they rejected that way. The rejection of God's Word is the reason for the missing dimension in knowledge. He concluded his lecture by telling the audience that he would reveal the true values to them the following night.

On Saturday evening the au-

dience was even larger. Mr. Goloh introduced Mr. Rader, who spoke briefly about future campaign plans.

Second Night's Lecture

As Mr. Armstrong began his lecture. I studied the audience to observe its reactions. For the most part, people were listening attentively and seemed eager to hear Mr. Armstrong expound more of the purpose of life.

He began by briefly summarizing Friday evening's fecture and then drew a comparison of conditions in Noah's time to the world situation today. He stated dogmatically that the true gospel had not been preached to the world in an organized manner for 18½ centuries and read from Malachi 3 and Mark I to show that the way for Christ's return is being prepared. He explained what the true gospel is — and what

Next. Mr. Armstrong took the audience back in time to the original creation, showing the origin of Satan and how God's government was at one time ruling the earth. Many in the audience heard for the first time the account of the recreation of the earth. He concluded the second night's lecture by explaining the difference between human and animal brain; how the spirit in man functions; and how Satan broadcasts his attitudes into the human mind.

Final Night

In largest audience of the three nights was on Sunday, May 19. Before Mr. Armstrong began his talk he was honored by the International Academy of Leadership as amoutstanding educator and world spiritual leader. This institute has honored such famous people as Franklin D. Roosevelt, Carlos P. Romulo, General Douglas Mac-Arthur and many others.

Following the invocation prayer. President Mercos's mother (who attended all three nights of the campaign) presented Mr. Armstrong with a copy of a Filipino poem dedi-

cated to the President and the First Lady.

Mr. Rader then briefly thanked the Filipino people and nation for their hospitality and told them Mr. Armstrong hoped to return at some future date to speak to them again. Mr. Rader then introduced Mr. Armstrong for the last time.

After recounting the pertinent points of the previous evenings. Mr. Armstrong continued to expound on the purpose of life. He spoke out strongly as he cut through cherished beliefs and traditions which have no basis in fact in God's Word. He explained again what love is and how God's government is based wholly on that principle,

Citing John 3, he told the audience how all human beings can be born again into the family of God. The seven-thousand-year plan was explained briefly, and also how all human beings are free moral agents with freedom of choice. Mr. Armstrong explained who Christ is and read the scriptures pertaining to the throne of David and Christ's earthly rule (Isatth 9:6; Luke 1:30-33).

The parable of the pounds (Luke 19) was expounded, along with the promise to the saints of rulership on earth at Jesus Christ's second coming Mr. Armstrong closed by stating how much more wonderful is the knowledge God reveals in the Bible than that taught by science, religion or education.

In his closing remarks, Mr. Gotohexplained to the audience that they were welcome to write to our office in Manila for any literature or additional information.

As Mr. Armstrong was leaving the stage, many people rushed up to get his autograph. In the Jobby area some of the ushers were asked questions by people interested in learning more.

The vast majority of the audience, regardless of their personal seeds, sat attentively trroughout all three nights.

Follow-up Bible studies are planned along with a direct-mail campaign to those who attended the meetings.

The brethren in the Philippines are looking forward to good growth as a result of Mr. Armstrong's very successful first campaign overseas.



The Good Sameritan

Christ described the story of a man (most likely a Jewish merchant) traveling from Jerusalem to Jericho Fersibly he had sold some goods there and was now tetuming home with the money. The journey from Jerusalem to Jericho was a lonely, dangerous twenty one milles of descri rous! Bandits frequented the route hoping to rob those traveling alone.

The man was situated by thieves, who even took his dothing. Left badly beaten by the side of the road, the man was half dead and urgently in need of help (verse 30).

By coincidence a lewish priest came by where the man lay. He would have been familias with the law quoted earlier, but perhaps he justified himself with the same technical question. Who is my neighbour?

The particular type of inn' being referred to here did not charge for lodging, only for food and sometimes entertainment. The Samantain gave the host enough money (two pence - about two days' labor - compare Matthew 20.2) to pay for the victim's food until he himself returned. He left strict instructions that the injured man was to be properly cared for in the meanume. Should the amount exceed what the Samaritan had given the impkeeper, he promised to make up the difference upon his return.

This was a shuning example of compassion on a fellow human being. The Samaritan certainly went "above and beyond" in caring for the man. He did more than would normally be expected.

With this indicting example burning in the mind of the lawyer, Iesus then asked the penetrating question: "Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?"

(Verse 36.)

What could the lawyer say? The priest and the the Levite had rendered no assistance whatsoever. Only the Samaritan had shown any concern—and then he had got everboard to help the man. But even at that the lawyer still didn't want to say the word "Samaritan"! He merely replied: He that shewed merey on him (were 37).

What This Parable Should Mean to You

This parable is not merely a quaint and interesting story of a first residency put down. It comveys one of the most important lessons of christianity. It is adomnatic to real Christianity that the time (thristianity that the needed).

Paul said: As we have therefore, opportunity, her as do good unto all men especially unto them who are of the bousehold of faith ((i.i.) 6:10). And: See that mone render cyllic evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good both among yourselves, and to all men (1 Thess. 5:15).

God is no respecter of persons. He is not partial to one rate or the other when it comes to showing compassion, hearing prayers and rendering help. God inspured Paul to write: There is neither Jew [typical Israehte] nor Greek [typical Gentile], there is neither boild nor free, there is neither male nor fremale: for we are all one in Christ Jesus (Gal. 3:28).

With God there is no racial prejudice, no status or social caste system, no "male" chausinism. All people of all races, sexes and social levels may be Christians. And it is the duty of all Christians to help all people who need help, whenever they have the opportunity to different them.

The meaning of the parable of the good Samaritan may be summed up by simply quoting a single provert "Withhold not good from them to whom it is due [your neighbor!] when it is in the power of thing hand to do it" (Prov. 3:27).

and for all he Faith Once Delivered

The New Testament book of Jude is a short but vivid account of what was happening in the first century Church of God. But it also contains a timely and powerful message for today's Christian!

FEEL COMPELLED to make my letter to you an earnest appeal to put up a real fight for the faith which has been once and for all committed to those who belong to Christ" (Jude 3, Phillips trans-

Many scholars believe that Jude's words were written relatively late inthe first century A.D. Perhaps all of the original apostles except John were now dead. Jude's first intent was to write a letter about the common salvation given to Christians. but a newly developing situation. had forced him to change his plans.

Jude had become aware of the great need to earnestly appeal to Christians to contend or fight for the faith which had been delivered to them. Apostasy was fast setting in; men were turning to error and leading away disciples after themselves. The Church was being divided.

What is the Faith?

Let's note carefully the meaningful words Jude used. He was urging them to detend the original faith they had been given Many of these people had been converted by the preaching of Christ's apostles. Some may have even heard Christ Himself. They got the truth firsthand - directly from the apostles.

who had obtained it from Christ who had faithfully delivered it from ? God the Father. There was no question about what the faith was. It had been faithfully given to them!

This faith, meaning in this sense the body of beliefs and practices handed down by the apostles, forms the essence of the meaning of God's Church. Together with the prophets. the apostolic teachings form the foundation of God's house - Jesus. Christ being the chief cornerstone (Eph. 2:20). Any superstructure not built upon this foundation is false; it will not stand (1 Cor. 3:10-15).

So, then, the faith which must be earnestly held on to and defended is that original set of beliefs handed down by Christ's apostles. Paul's writings are full of warnings of false teachers who sought to mislead the people of God.

Paul was often amazed at how, easy it was for the false teachers to deceive the ones he had nourished in the faith, He fold the Galatians that he marveled at how soon they were removed from Christ's gospel and had seepted another (Gal. 196). The New Jestament Church. was constantly being harassed by false brethren who so that to mislead God's people.

So we see that in just a few years the New Testament Church was facing great internal problems It is no wonder that by the time Jude wrote This epistle, perhaps in the 70s or 80s. he had to urgently remind them to stand up for the truth which they had received from the apostles.

The Apostles' Teachings

But one may ask: What about us today? How can we know the truth? This world is filled with various religions, and even Christianity is divided and subdivided many times over. Upon what can we base our faithe today?

The answer is given by Paul, who told his fellow minister Timothy: "All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching the faith and correcting error, for resetting the direction of a man's life and training him in good living" (II Tim. 3:16, Phillips).

To get back to the faith, to know. and come to understand that faith, one must study the writings of the apostles and the prophets. It is the purpose of Scripture to give us insight into that original set of beliefs. God has not left us without a witness today. 🔭 "

If Jude were alive today, he would say the same thing to us as he did to those first-century Christians. Stick with the teachings of Scripture. Don't follow contrary ideas: don't follow a man (I Cor. 3:21). The scriptural principle is to prove all things and hold on to only that which is good (I Thess. 5:21). It is in "this vein that Jude urged: ".... Build yourselves up on the foundation of your most holy faith and by praying through the Holy Spirit keep yourselves within the love of God" (Jude 20. Phillips). We have a personal. responsibility to attend to our own salvation (see also Phil. 2:12).

Principles of Error

While Jude's writings do not give a listing of the specific false doctrines he was combating, he does give us many categories and analogies which fit such false telechers. By wisely studying the rest of the Bible.

we can understand the context of Jude's statements.

Jude likens these ungodly men to

1) the unbelieving Israelites who
were destroyed in the wilderness, 2)
the evil angels who rebelled against
God, and 3) the cities of Sodom and
Gomorrah which perished because
of their sexual sins (verses 5-7).

Then in verse 8 he says: "Like-wise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities." Here Jude appears to reverse the order of verses 5-7. They "defile the flesh" like the inhabitants of Sodom and Gomorrah. They despise government like the angels who rebelled against God. And they "speak evil of dignities" like those Israelites in the wilderness who continually rebelled against Moses.

So here we have three main characteristics of those who were trying to introduce error into the Church:

One sexual sins. But as God views them, they are analogous to wrong relationships between His people and the world. James wrote: "Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is earnity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God" (James 4.4). And is it not significant that the false Christianity of this world has political intercourse with the nations of the earth?

Two: despising government. The evil angels were the first to attempt to usurp God's authority. Just as Satan tried to influence Eve to listen to him rather than God, so these false teachers tried to replace the authority of God. Jude had earlier plainly said that they disown Jesus Christ, our only Sovereign and Lord" (Jude 4. last part; see Weymouth, The New English Bible, Phillips, Moffatt and other modern translations of the Bible). They set themselves up as authorities in place of God and the teachings of Christ.

Three: they speak evil of dignities. The wanderings of the Israelites in the wilderness is a chronicle of rebellion against Moses. In like manner, these false teachers set themselves up against the Moses of the New Testament: Jesus Christ. Moses himself foresaw the coming of the great Prophet of the New Testament who would be like himself (Deut. 18:15). And Peter, on the Day of Pentecost, verified that Christ is that Moses (Acts 3:20°23).

These false teachers sought to take the place of the Rock (Christ - I Corinthians 10:1-12: Deuteronomy 32), It is now Christ who is leading His Spirit-begotten people into the Promised Land (His Kingdom), and He is capable of doing this without fail: "Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultiess before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy; to the only wise God out Saviour, be glory and majesty dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen" (Jude 24-25).

Three Examples of Error

Jude also uses three vivid examples from the Old Testament to clarify what type of individuals were worming their way into the Charch.

"Woe to them! for they have followed in the steps of Cain; for the sake of gain, they have rushed on headlong in the errors of Balaan, and have perished in the rebellion of Korah." (Jude 11 Weymouth.)

First: Cain, Cain is notorious for the slaying of his brother. In like manner, such false teachers are haters of the brethren and, as such, are murderers in the sight of God. The Apostle John, who lived to see the apostasy at the end of the first century, also vividly described these false teachers when he said: "Little children, let no man deceive you.... For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another. Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death. Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him" (I John 3:7, 11-12, 14-15).

By their false doctrine these false teachers were dividing the Church. And the true Christians were put out of the visible Church and the visible Church and the visible Church persecuted God's people. Already in the days of the Apostle John, at the end of the first century, an apparent elder by the name of Diotrephes cast out of the Church any of his people who would have fellowship with the disciples of John (III John 9-10). This trend continued and eventually many were following the errorists (II Pet. 2:1-2).

Second: Balaam. The king of Moab hired the prophet Balaam to pronounce a curse upon the Israelites (Num. 22-24). Balaam lusted after the great wealth that the king wanted to give him if he would but curse Israel. Although God used him to utter inspired prophecy. Balaam led the Israelites into sexual sin and was later killed (Num. 31:8; 16). In like manner, these false men of the New Testament were after the money of the Christians for their own gain. Peter said they, like Balaam, "loved the wages of unrighteousness" (II Pet 2,15), God's true ministers, serve secause they love the people.

Three: Korah Korah was jealous of Moses and sought to usurp his leadership (Num. 16). In the same way, these false ministers sought to usurp the leadership of the New Testament Moses: Jesus Christ, The Scriptures continually point out how Christ - and not any man - is the. Head of His Church. We read that "God has placed everything under the power of Christ and has set him up as head of everything for the Church, For the Church is his body. and in that body lives fully the one who fills the whole wide universe" (Eph. 1:22-23, Phillips).

And later Paul also says: "We are not meant to remain as children at the mercy of every chance wind of teaching and the jockeying of men who are expert in the crafty presentation of lies. But we are meant to hold firmly to the truth in love, and

to grow up in every way into Christ, the head. For it is from the head that the whole body, as a harmonious structure knit together by the joints with which it is provided, grows by the proper functioning of individual parts to its full maturity in love", (Eph. 4:14-16, Phillips).

How great a contrast to these false teachings which would enslave men to men! How much greater it is to recognize Christ as the living, active Head than some mortal man!

Like Korah of old, these men set themselves up as equals of the New Testament Moses — Jesus Christ. But this Moses Himself prophesied of them: "In that day many will say to me. "Lord, Lord, didn't we preach in your name, didn't we tast out devils in your name, and do many great things in your name?" Then I shall tell them plainly have never known you. Go away from me, you have worked on the sideofevil!" (Man 7:22-23 Phillips.)

For Us Today

The 900 years since the writing of Jude has seen the apostasy grow and overwhelm the world. Many of the obiginal teachings of Christ and the apostes have been forgotten in a parade of man-originated outtoms and doctrines.

Now is the time to return to the faith which was truly once and for all delivered by Christ and the apostles. And the only true remedy is a sincere and willing heart coupled with a diligent searching of the Scriptures to see whether these things be so.

In the final book of the Bible. Christ is pictured as standing in the midst of the seven candlesticks (Rey 1:13). So we would be sure to understand. Jesus interprets the meaning of the candlesticks for us in verse 20. They represent the seven churches of Revelation 2 and 3.

the message of Revelation is addressed. In the time of the Apostle John, these seven churches existed in the Roman province of Asia (now Asia Minor in western Turkey). And

to these churches—and to future Christians—Christ addressed some dire warnings.

Taken as literally applying to the seven extant churches at the time of John, we can only draw the conclusion that many were already showing growing signs of corruption and apostasy. But taken in the future sense, it bears a warning to Christians today to be alert and hear what Christ inspited John to write to the seven churches.

And in this connection note the manner in which Christ appeared in the midst of the seven candlesticks: "His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow, and his eyes were as a flame of fire; and his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters. And he had in his right hand seven stars; and out of his mouth went a sharp two edged sword, and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength," (Rev. 1.14-16).

It is a God of power and might who stands in the midst, of His churches, Risen from the dead, alive forever more, Ruler of the kings of the earth, from whose mouth issues a sharp two-edged sword! Such a graphic description of Christ was surely meant to inspire faith in His leadership, and by implication is a warning against those who would follow false doctring and apostasy.

But in spite of problems, we need not fail if we will but put our trust and hope in our Leader, the Moses of our exodus out of sin and into the Kingdom of God. Jesus Christ.



But Christ was faithful as a son in the household of his own Father. And we are members of this household it we maintain our trust and joyful hope steadfast to the end.

"You should therefore be most careful my brothers, that there should not be in any of you that

wickedness of heart which refuses to trust, and deserts the cause of the living God. Help each other to stand firm in the faith every day, while it is still called 'today' and beware that none of you becomes deaf and blind to God through the delusive glamour of sin

"Let us then be eager to know this rest for ourselves, and let us beware that no one misses it through falling into the same kind of unbelief as those we have mentioned. For the Word that God speaks is alive and active; it cuts more keenly than any two-edged sword ... it exposes the very thoughts and motives of a man's heart. No creature has any cover from the sight of God; everything lies naked and exposed before the eyes of him with whom we have to do" (Heb. 3:5-6, 12-13; 4:11-13, Phillips).

It is this two-edged sword of His written Word which is still with us today, ready to weed out error in doctrine and to reset our direction. It is the only means whereby-we can know, and be sure that we know, the faith which was once and for all delivered to God's people.

and he will aftempt to score a touchdown. Give a base-ball to a pitcher and he'll try to strike out the batter. Give a Bible to a Christian and he may play games with it too! He also will try to score points — points measured in feelings of self-righteousness and superiority.

The Bible does not naturally lend itself to this exaltation of the human ego. It thrusts and parries at our follies and frailties, exposing human nature for what it really is. "For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged

sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart? (Heb. 4:12).

But in the hands of a game-playing Christian, the sword of the Lord can be blunted or even wielded on other people instead of being applied personally. The rules for doing this are few and simple:

1) Forget or disbelieve that the Bible is true and factual revelation. "Thy word is truth," said Christ (John 17:17) But this must be overlooked.

2) Don't approach the Bible with humility, and don't fear to misuse or misinterpret it. "... To this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word," says God in Isaiah 66:2. But that's in the Old Testament and hasn't that been done away with?

3) Forget that God gave the Bible to instruct, correct and change people — and you are "people," too. Disregard such scriptures as II Timothy 3:16, 17: "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works."

So casy are these rules to follow that anyone can play. And, sure enough, most do at one time or another. So as you read about these games, don't point the ferreting finger of fault-finding at someone else. That, as you may remember, is playing the games of "Blemish" and "Comparison Shopping." Apply the games personally.

Ignore-Amos (And the Rest of the Bible, Tool)

The first game professing Christians play with the Bible is to ignore it altogether. "Ignore-amoses" darken the doors of their church more often than they read the Bible. They can tell you the top five teams in the National League, but can't

tell you the first five books of the Bible — in either Testament. Yet they have little or no doubt that they are genuine Christians who will be reckoned with the sheep, and not the goats, at the Judgment.

The next worse thing to avoiding the Bible altogether is to use it in "Prop." This game is played by being seen with the Bible in public — but avoiding it in private. What counts is not how well you know the Bible — but your ability to show it off.

A typical "Prop" game is played once a week on the way to church. The player carries the Word of the Lord conspicuously to be seen of men - and reverently to be seen of God - on his way to services. However, he must be careful! someone on earth or in heaven may notice that the Bible looks as new as when it was purchased ten years ago. Experienced players avoid this embarrassing faux pas by thumbing through the pages during services to give it that dog-eared, well-worn, well-read look. Or even better, the Bible is given to the baby to play with during the week.

"Display"

"Display" or "Part of the Furniture" is similar to "Prop," but is played at home. The Bible is strategically placed on the coffee table or nightstand for the benefit of guests or visitors. The conclusion they will form about their host's piety is, of course, unmistakable. But like an original piece of Louis XIV furniture, it is there to be looked at - not to be used. Its sole value lies in its prestige. "Display" is also seen at formal occasions such as weddings, installations, anniversary parties, etc. - where a Bible is needed to lend an air of spirituality to the

As any good Bible salesman knows, the feelings of spiritual superiority are directly proportional to the weight, size and cost of a Bible. Extra pseudo-spiritual points can be won in "Display" when:

1) The Bible covers at least two square feet when opened to the 23rd Psalm (10 points)

2) It weighs at least ten pounds (20 points)

3) It comes with gold lettering, genuine leather cover (preferably white), indexing, (we've pictures of the Holy Land, and a reproduction of the Lord's Supper" by Leonardo da Vinci (30 points)

4) It costs at least \$50.00 (50 points)

5) It has been a family heirloom for at least three generations (100 points)

6) It is a. Gutenberg original (1,000 points!).

Read the Book

Could you be an "ignore-amos" or a "Prop" player to one degree or another when it comes to the Bible? Is your Bible only a prop or a piece of furniture? Or is it something you continually read — and live by?

Here's a quick test to find out. It never fails to divide game players from real readers: Does the book of Josiah precede or follow Nahum? If you aren't sure or have to look it up—you need to write for our free booklet Read the Book. It gives the antidote for being a Bible "ignoreamos."

The "Knowbody"

Let us pass on to the game players who do read the Bible, who give the appearance of sinking their teeth into the "meat of the Word." But, remember, in all games, appearances are deceiving. For while these people may be readers of the Word — they are not doers (James 1:22-25). Spiritually speaking, such a person is a "knowbody." — someone who is more concerned about impressing himself and others with what he knows about the Bible than actually obeying it.

Here are some of the games they play.

"Shelf-Righteousness"

Some players measure their spiritual and intellectual prowess by the

volume and density of Bible commentaries, dictionaries, translations, pamphlets and articles amassed on their shelves. They become very "shelf-righteous" about this outward display of apparent biblical knowledge. (Not that there is anything wrong with a good collection of reference books — it's how they are used!)

Perhaps some have forgotten what Paul said: "Knowledge puffeth up, but charity ediffeth" (I Cor. 8:1); and "Though! have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge. and have not charity [love], I am nothing (I Cor. 13:2). What they need is shelf-restraint, or better yet, shelf-abasement (most of their books should be relegated to the basement!).

"Ivory Tower"

In the same league with the shelf-righteous are the players of "Ivory Tower" or "Pious Pedestal." They preach faith, hope and charity to their fellowman, but are woefully short on practicing it themselves.

This game was vividly demonstrated recently in an experiment conducted at Princeton University. Two researchers placed 40 aspiring theologians in a test situation similar to the parable of the "Good Samaritan." They told the students to walk to a nearby building and dictate an impromptu talk — some on the parable of the Good Samaritan, others on their career concerns.

Along the pathway was planted an actor who, as the unsuspecting student approached, groaned and slumped to the ground. How did they ceact? Sixty percent walked right on by! Some, who were to talk on the "Good Samaritan," literally stepped over the slumped body as they hurried along!

"It Ain't Necessarily

This is one of the most popular games of all time. It is played by atheists, agnostics, liberal theologians – anyone who feels uncomfortable taking the Bible iteratly. If they come across anything in the Bible that doesn't agree with their thinking, it has got to be in error. On paper and in pulpits they immediately strike up a refrain of "It Ain't Necessarily So." They would rather change the Bible to fit their ideas, than change their ideas—and lives—to conform to the Bible.

On the flip side of the coin is the game, "The Bible Says"..." Whereas in "It Ain't Necessarily So" the goal is to read out objectionable parts of the Bible, the goal in "The Bible Says..." is to read into the Bible ideas, words and sentences that aren't there! Thus, "the Bible says that heaven is the reward of the saved"; "the Bible says the soul is immortal"; "the Bible says Sunday is the Lord's day." But the Bible says none of these!

Undoubtedly, this statement will send some scurrying to their Bibles to prove otherwise. Good. We have made these statements hundreds of times on the air and in our literature to shock people out of taking their God and their Bible for granted and to start doing what the Bereans did with the preaching of Paul: "These were more noble, than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the Scriptures daily, whether those things were so "(Acts 17:11).

Before you send us your "proof" to refute these statements about heaven, the soul, and the Sabbath, be sure you are not guilty of playing these games:

Give Me That Old Time Religion — But Not the Old Testament

Some people have the sincere, but mistaken, notion that the Old Testament is done away with and is of no value in establishing doctrine. But they forget that when Paul made his statement (quoted earlier in this article) about the usefulness of God's Word ("profitable for doctrine") the New Testament canon was not in existence! He was referring to the Old Testament Scriptures. So was Christ when He said to Satan: "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God" (Matt. 4:4).

Mirage: This involves seeing things in a verse that aren't really there. For example, people read "mansions" in John 14:2, 3 and automatically see "heaven." (To find out what these "mansions" are write for our free booklet What Is the Reward of the Saved.)

Scalpel and Forcess. This is the technique of lifting a verse out of context to change its application or intent. For example, this is frequently done with Revelation 1:10 ("on the Lord's day") to prove Sun-

day-keeping. (The biblical meaning of the "Lord's day" is explained in our booklet The Book of Revelation Unveiled at Last.)

Plastic Surgery: The person tries to rework the verse to make the meaning more agreeable to his thinking.

Stock the Deck: Like a cardsharp fixing his deck in order to win, some people try to select the scriptures that "support" their argument, and leave out those that don't.

An invaluable help to using the Word of God is our booklet How to Study the Bible. It shows how to stop playing games with the Bible — and start to study it and understand what it really says. Be sure to write for your copy!

"Prove All Things"

The Bible exhorts every person who thinks he is a Christian to "Prove all things; hold fast that which is good" (I Thess. 5:21). Otherwise, you might be a game-playing Christian, a sham, a hypocrite. Your "religion" may comfort you now — but when Christ blows the whistle on the games "Christians" play and starts to divide the sheep and goats—are you sure you'll be on the right side?
